The Pollegio festival site does not have parking spaces for guests. These can be found in the «Pista Ghiaccio Comunale», via Stradone Vecchio sud 29, 6710 Biasca. Please note the signage from the Biasca motorway exit. The parking spaces are a few minutes' walk from Biasca railway station (path signposted). You will be taken by shuttle bus from Biasca railway station to the festival site. Buses leave every half hour, from 10.30 to 11.30. The journey takes around 10 minutes.
